NOTICE TO PLAYERS

USGA rules shall govern all play unless otherwise specified.

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

FORMAT: **Division 1 - 2:** 18 Hole; Scramble
 Division 3: 9-Hole; Scramble

TEES: **Div 1 Men** – Championship **Women** – Regular
 Div 2 Men – Regular **Women** – Resort
 Division 3 Men & Women – Forward (Red)

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: Note under Rule 14-3 is in effect. During the competition, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only.

TIES: All ties will be broken using USGA Rules of Golf Appendix I recommended method.

LOCAL RULES

DISREGARD ALL LOCAL RULES PRINTED ON SCORECARD AND LOCAL SIGNAGE REGARDING RULES

PENALTY AREAS are defined by Yellow stakes and/or lines. Where stakes and lines are used, stakes identify the hazard and lines define the boundary of the area. **Hole #16 & Hole #18**

LATERAL PENALTY AREAS are defined by Red stakes and/or lines. Where stakes and lines are used, stakes identify the area and lines define the boundary of the area.

Hole #5 – Crossing Fairway

Hole #6 – Baranka from tee to green

Hole #10 – The Lake and Stream splitting fairway

Hole #11 – Lake Left of the green

Holes 16/17 – Ocean and area near cliffs.

OUT OF BOUNDS is defined by inside points at ground level of white stakes, boundary walls, white lines, perimeter fence posts and inside edge of curbing on public roads. Note that the concrete bases of the fence posts are part of the boundary fence and therefore are not obstructions. Any ball crossing a public road and coming to rest on another part of the course is out of bounds.

RELIEF – shall be granted from all paved cart paths, utility boxes or other immovable obstructions

FORMAT OF PLAY: ALL PLAYERS IN GROUP WILL TEE OFF. YOU WILL THEN SELECT YOUR FAVORITE SHOT AND ALL PLAYERS WILL PLAY FROM THAT LOCATION, SELECTING THE BEST SHOT UNTIL THE FIRST BALL IS HOLED.

ONCE BALL IS HOLED THE SCORE CAN BE RECORDED. FOR DIVISION 1 AND 2 A MINIMUM OF 4 TEE SHOTS MUST BE USED. FOR DIVISION 3 A MINIMUM OF 2 TEE SHOTS MUST BE USED.
